

How does the pan-London admissions system work?

- Managed centrally organises admissions for all schools
- Uses each school's own admissions criteria to select children who will be offered places
- If a child does not get a place at one of their higherpreference schools, the system automatically places them on the waiting list at that school
- If a child does not get a place at any of their preferred schools, Camden admissions will attempt to offer the nearest Camden school that has a vacancy. Bear in mind this means it will not be your choice of school



Admissions Criteria:

"Most families when applying for an oversubscribed Camden community secondary school will be considered under the distance criteria if there are no special factors or siblings at those schools"

- Other factors that are part of some schools' admissions criteria include:
 - Children in foster care/looked after or previously looked after
 - Music aptitude (e.g. Haverstock, Camden School for Girls)
 - Sibling in Y7 to 10, or Y12
 - Exceptional medical or social need
 - Parent is a teacher at the school
 - For Catholic schools baptism status





Information needed for the online application

- Parental responsibility
- Proof of your child's DOB (e.g. birth certificate, NHS medical card)
- Proof of address (e.g. utility bill from last 3 months, Council Tax statement)
- Multiple addresses if a child lives at two different addresses, the application must be based on the address at which the child spends the majority of the school week
- Camden will not accept a temporary address that is used solely or mainly to obtain a school place

Information needed for the online application

- Exceptional medical or social reason letter from suitable qualified professional e.g. doctor, social worker
- Voluntary aided schools supplementary forms may be required (see p12 of Camden brochure)
- Children with an EHCP should apply through the Camden SEN team rather than the ordinary secondary transfer process

Myth busting

Myth – Listing one school on your form will mean that the council will have to offer that school.

If we apply the admissions arrangements and your child cannot be offered a place because you live too far away, we will not be able to offer a place at the school. Listing only one school on your application does not increase your chances of gaining a place at that school.

Myth – If you live nearer to the school than the last child offered under the distance criterion last year you will be guaranteed a place.

Although the information on page 52 can give you an idea of how likely it is that you will be offered a place at your preferred school, the 'furthest distance' will change every year. We can never guarantee any child will be offered a place at any school. Myth – Children living on my road go to the school so my child will too. The number of pupils offered under each criterion at each school can change every year so just because you know pupils living near you that go to a certain school, it does not mean that your child will be offered a place there.

Myth – If I work close to the school, the distance is from my work to the school.

The proximity of your workplace has no bearing on your application – we will measure your distance from your home to the school.

Myth busting

Myth – If I have a sibling enrolled at a faith school I will get higher priority. This may not always be the case, as some faith schools rank regular worship at a particular church above siblings. Please check the admissions criteria for your selected faith school.

Myth – My child's Key Stage 2 test results will affect their chance of securing a school place.

The Key Stage 2 test results do not form part of the admissions criteria for any of Camden's community, voluntary aided schools, or UCL Academy, so your child's results will not be considered.

Myth – The oversubscription criteria never changes.

Each year the council consults on the admissions criteria for the community schools and the oversubscription criteria can vary from year to year.

Myth – I can only apply for Camden schools.

You can apply for both Camden and out of borough schools by listing them on your application. If applying for a voluntary aided school, you should check with the school to see if they require a supplementary form to be completed as well.

Myth busting

Myth – If I apply to a school in another borough, their residents will have priority over me.

A council cannot give preference to its own residents and published admissions criteria cannot include the borough of residence. Camden cannot and does not discriminate between applicants who live in the borough and those who do not. However, check the admissions criteria with the appropriate authority if applying to a school in another borough. Myth – It does not matter if my application is late. If you apply after Monday 31 October 2022 your application will not be considered until after all those who have applied on time and it is very unlikely that you will be offered one of your preferred schools.

Myth – My school place cannot be withdrawn once it has been offered to me.

Once the council has made an offer of a school place, it can only be lawfully withdrawn in very limited circumstances. This may happen where an application is found to be fraudulent or a parent has not responded to an offer within the specified timescale.

Offer day

- Results out 5pm on 1st March 2023
- Website traffic is very busy that day which can cause crashes
- You can login to find out the allocation for your child, but you will also be sent an email (this can take some time)
- App Parent Comms can be used to find out information if the website crashes
- It is important to accept the place offered even if it is not a school that you wanted; if not your child will not remain on any waiting lists for the schools that you do prefer
- London has a very mobile population so places can become available; you can contact Camden (or other authority) admissions to find out about your place on any waiting lists
