Camden schools sports hall athletics championships





On Thursday 10th January the year 5/6 athletics team took part in the Camden Schools sports hall athletics championships and finished a very respectable 4th out of the 14 schools taking part. The children were a little disappointed to miss out on the top 3 but should be proud of their amazing team performance. They had worked very hard attending some extra practice to get ready and I felt beforehand that if everyone did their best we could finish in the top 5 but might just sneak into 3rd so I was very happy with our result. Some of the highlights for me were as follows:

Milo - am amazing personal best in the standing long jump of 1.92m. His previous best was 1.60!! Along with the Gaspard and Jae'von they were the best team in Camden at this event!

Luke - another fantastic personal best of 5.02m in the triple jump when his previous best was 4.65!! Gaspard performed a truly exceptional 5.78m but was pushed back into second place by an out of this world performance by a boy from Gospel oak (5.98).

Farah - a brilliant 7.25m chest push which is her personal best.

Laci - with a super fast 45 in the speed bounce. She has performed an incredible 48 this year!

Lola - a very springy 1.92m in the standing long jump.






Camden inclusive gymnastics
